

TECH-X CORPORATION
QScimpl SOFTWARE LICENSE AGREEMENT

0. RECITALS.

- (a) This Tech-X Corporation Royalty-Free Public License Agreement for QScimpl Software ("License") is a legal agreement between you and Tech-X Corporation ("Tech-X") for the use of the QScimpl Software (the "Software"), as defined below. If you are installing the software for personal use, this agreement applies to and binds you personally. If you are installing the software as part of your work for an organization, this agreement applies to and binds such organization. "LICENSEE" or "YOU" and "YOUR" refer to the person or entity that is licensee of the software.
- (b) By installing, copying, or otherwise using the Software or any work derived from the Software, Licensee accepts this License, and agrees to be bound by all of its terms and conditions. No rights are granted to the Software except as expressly set forth herein. Nothing other than this License grants Licensee permission to use, copy or modify the Software or any work derived from the Software. If Licensee does not accept the terms and conditions of this License, it should not use, copy or modify the Software.
- (c) Licensee acknowledges that he, she, or it will not in any way use the Software for any commercial purposes. In consideration for Licensee's forbearance of commercial use of the Software, Tech-X grants Licensee non-exclusive, royalty-free rights as expressly provided herein.

1. DEFINITIONS.

- (a) "Software" means the QScimpl software, including the QScimpl libraries, configuration and build scripts, examples, interface definitions, associated media and printed materials, and any electronic documentation including but not limited to HTML and PDF formats.
- (b) "Documentation" means printed, electronic or online documentation purchased from Tech-X or provided by Tech-X to licensees of its corresponding proprietary QScimpl software.
- (c) "Internal" means use is limited to Licensee, its employees, and contractors performing work for Licensee's benefit, but not Licensee's customers or other third parties.
- (d) "License Fee Agreement" means the business transaction document(s) between Licensee and Tech-X (such as, but not limited to Tech-X quotations, purchase orders from Licensee and Tech-X's corresponding acknowledgements, and Tech-X invoices) which define the agreed parameters of use of the Software, including pricing, and which identify the number of processors and applicable computer(s) on which Licensee may use the Software. "License Fee Agreement" excludes each party's preprinted boilerplate terms of purchase or sale on such transactional document(s) and all such preprinted terms and conditions of purchase or sale are hereby rejected.
- (e) A "work derived from the Software" is any derivative work as defined in 17 U.S.C. paragraph 101, including for example, any translation, improvement, enhancement, extension, incorporation, or other modification of the Software. A work derived from the Software is also referred to as "Modified Software" or "Derivative Works" in this Agreement.
- (f) To "use" means to execute (i.e., run) the Software.
- (g) The "developer" is the Licensee or anyone acting as an agent of the Licensee who causes use of the Software by
 - (i) creating a derived work that uses the Software's application programming interface or
 - (ii) causing a derived work to be linked to the Software libraries
- (h) To "copy" means to create one or more copies as defined in 17 U.S.C. paragraph 101.
- (i) To "distribute" means to broadcast, publish, transfer, post, upload, download or otherwise disseminate in any medium to any third party.
- (j) To "modify" means to create a work derived from the Software, also known in this Agreement as "Modified Software" or "Derivative Work," or to change or alter any aspect of the Software.
- (k) A "commercial purpose" or "commercial purposes" means any use of the Software or any Derivative Works for, as part of, or in any way in connection with a product (including software) or service that will be sold, offered for sale, licensed, leased, loaned, rented, or otherwise made available commercially.
- (l) A "non-commercial purpose" or "non-commercial purposes" means use of the Software and any Derivative Works solely for education, research or internal use by the Licensee.
- (m) "User" refers to one or more identified individuals each of whom will Internally use a Copy of Software.

2. GRANT OF LICENSE.

- (a) **License to Use.** Licensee may use the Software in the manner described in this Software License for non-commercial purposes.
- (b) **License to Copy.** Licensee may create literal (i.e., verbatim) copies of the Software as Licensee requires for backup purposes or to create multiple instances of use.
- (c) **License to Create Derivative Works.** A single developer may create works derived from the Software for non-commercial purposes.
- (d) **License to Distribute Software.** Tech-X Corporation grants to the Licensee a non-exclusive right to distribute the QScimpl libraries in object code form solely for use in Licensee's Derivative Works for non-commercial purposes.
- (e) **Separate license to be negotiated for any commercial purpose.** If Licensee desires a commercial use license to the Software, Licensee must obtain a separate fee-bearing commercial license from Tech-X.

3. RESTRICTIONS.

- (a) **Ownership.** Licensee acknowledges that the Software is protected by copyright laws and international copyright treaties, as well as other intellectual property laws and treaties. The Software and Documentation is licensed, not sold. Tech-X retains sole and exclusive ownership of all right, title, and interest in and to the Software and Documentation, and all copies thereof, subject only to the licenses expressly granted to Licensee herein. This Agreement does not provide Licensee with title or ownership of the Software and Documentation, but only a revocable license of limited use.
- (b) **Copyrights.** All title and copyrights in and to the Software, including but not limited to any images, photographs, databases, animations, video, text and "applets" incorporated into the Software, the accompanying printed materials, and any copies of the Software, are exclusively owned by Tech-X.
- (c) **Reverse Engineering.** Licensee may not modify, reverse engineer or decompile the Software except as permitted by this License.
- (d) **Distribution Restriction.** Licensee may not assign or transfer this License, the Software, Modified Software, or any work derived from the Software, except as permitted by this License.
- (e) **Developer Sublicense Restriction.** Licensee may not sublicense the Software to a contract developer.
- (f) **Export Restriction.** If using, copying, distributing and/or modifying the Software is restricted in certain countries for any reason, Tech-X Corporation may in the future add an explicit geographical distribution limitation excluding those countries, so that using, copying, distributing and/or modifying is permitted only in or among countries not thus excluded. In such case, this License incorporates the limitation as if written in the body of this License.
- (g) **U.S. Laws and Export Restriction.** Licensee acknowledges that the Software is subject to U.S. export laws and regulations and any use of or transfer of such Software must be authorized under those regulations. The obligations of this written assurance shall survive the term of this or any other related agreement.

4. SERVICE AND SUPPORT

The service and support that Tech-X offers for the Software under this License are limited to the service or support, if any, that is described on Tech-X's website.

5. NO WARRANTIES.

TECH-X CORPORATION EXPRESSLY DISCLAIMS ANY WARRANTY FOR THE SOFTWARE OR MODIFIED SOFTWARE CREATED BY LICENSEE. THE SOFTWARE IS PROVIDED TO LICENSEE "AS IS," WITHOUT WARRANTY OF ANY KIND, EITHER EXPRESS OR IMPLIED, INCLUDING, WITHOUT LIMITATION, THE IMPLIED WARRANTIES OF MERCHANTABILITY, FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE AND NON-INFRINGEMENT OF THIRD PARTY RIGHTS. THE LICENSEE BEARS THE ENTIRE RISK AS TO THE USE, QUALITY AND PERFORMANCE OF THE SOFTWARE. LICENSEE EXPRESSLY ASSUMES THE COST OF ALL NECESSARY SERVICING, REPAIR OR CORRECTION, SHOULD THE SOFTWARE PROVE DEFECTIVE.

6. NO LIABILITY FOR DAMAGES.

IN NO EVENT WILL TECH-X CORPORATION, OR ANY OTHER PARTY WHO MAY COPY MODIFY THE SOFTWARE AS PERMITTED HEREIN, BE LIABLE FOR ANY GENERAL, DIRECT, INDIRECT, INCIDENTAL, SPECIAL OR CONSEQUENTIAL DAMAGES WHATSOEVER (INCLUDING, WITHOUT LIMITATION, DAMAGES FOR LOSS OF BUSINESS PROFITS, BUSINESS INTERRUPTION, INACCURATE

INFORMATION, LOSS OF INFORMATION, OR ANY OTHER PECUNIARY LOSS) ARISING OUT OF THE USE OR INABILITY TO USE THE SOFTWARE, EVEN IF TECH-X CORPORATION OR SUCH OTHER PARTY HAS BEEN ADVISED OF THE POSSIBILITY OF SUCH DAMAGES.

7. INFRINGEMENT CLAIMS

Tech-X will defend at its own expense, indemnify and hold Licensee harmless in any action brought against Licensee on a claim that the Software infringes any third party's patent or copyright, provided that Licensee promptly notifies Tech-X in writing of such claim, Tech-X has sole control over the defense of the claim and/or any settlement negotiations, and Licensee cooperates fully in the defense of the claim. Tech-X will pay those costs and damages finally awarded against Licensee in any such claim. At its option, Tech-X may, in lieu of any other claims by Licensee for indemnification, obtain the right for Licensee to continue using the Software, or repair it, replace it or terminate this Agreement, including any licenses granted herein. **The foregoing states Tech-X's entire obligation to Licensee for indemnification of third party infringement claims.**

8. U.S. GOVERNMENT RESTRICTED RIGHTS.

If Software is being acquired by or on behalf of the U.S. Government or by a U.S. Government prime contractor or subcontractor (at any tier), then the Government's rights in Software and accompanying documentation will be only as set forth in this License; this is in accordance with 48 CFR 227.7201 through 227.7202-4 (for Department of Defense (DOD) acquisitions) and with 48 CFR 2.101 and 12.212 (for non-DOD acquisitions). 9. TERM AND TERMINATION.

- (a) This license is perpetual.
- (b) Any violation or any attempt to violate any of the terms and conditions of this License will automatically terminate Licensee's rights under this License.
- (c) Licensee agrees upon termination to cease any and all use, copying, distributing and modifying of the Software and any work derived from the Software, and further to destroy any and all of Licensee's copies of the Software and any work derived from the Software.

10. CONFIDENTIALITY

Licensee agrees to maintain in confidence the confidential information of Tech-X, including any source code to any Tech-X software programs to which Licensee has access. Licensee further agrees not to disclose such Tech-X confidential information to anyone other than employees or contractors of the Licensee who have a need to know or obtain access to such information in order to support Licensee's authorized use of the Software who are bound, by a written agreement, to protect such information against any other use or disclosure.

11. LICENSE SCOPE AND MODIFICATION.

This License sets forth the entire agreement between Licensee and Tech-X and supersedes all prior agreements and understandings between the parties relating to the subject matter hereof. None of the terms of this License may be waived or modified except as expressly agreed in writing by both Licensee and Tech-X.

12. SEVERABILITY.

Should any provision of this License be declared void or unenforceable, the validity of the remaining provisions shall not be affected.

13. GOVERNING LAWS AND FORUM.

- (a) This License is governed by, and shall be interpreted in accordance with, the laws of the State of Colorado, U.S.A.
- (b) Licensee hereby consents to jurisdiction and venue in a state or federal court situated in Boulder, Colorado or Denver, Colorado for any action stemming from this License.
